## Designing Graphics in Photoshop

### Actions

### Interface

**Options for selected tool/object** (green arrow pointing to the top toolbar)

**Character and Paragraph panels** (green arrow pointing to the top right panels)

**Layer opacity** (red arrow pointing to the Opacity dropdown in the Layers panel)

**Fill opacity** (red arrow pointing to the Fill dropdown in the Layers panel)

**Lock/unlock layer** (red arrow pointing to the lock icon in the Layers panel)

**Vector mask** (red arrow pointing to the vector mask icon in the Layers panel)

**Link/unlink mask** (red arrow pointing to the link icon in the Layers panel)

**Show/hide layer** (red arrow pointing to the eye icon in the Layers panel)

**Layers panel** (green arrow pointing to the Layers panel)

**Type tool** (red arrow pointing to the 'T' icon in the toolbar)

**Shape tool** (red arrow pointing to the shape tool icons in the toolbar)

**Delete layer** (red arrow pointing to the trash icon at the bottom of the Layers panel)

**Create new layer** (red arrow pointing to the plus icon at the bottom of the Layers panel)

**Create new group** (red arrow pointing to the folder icon at the bottom of the Layers panel)
