



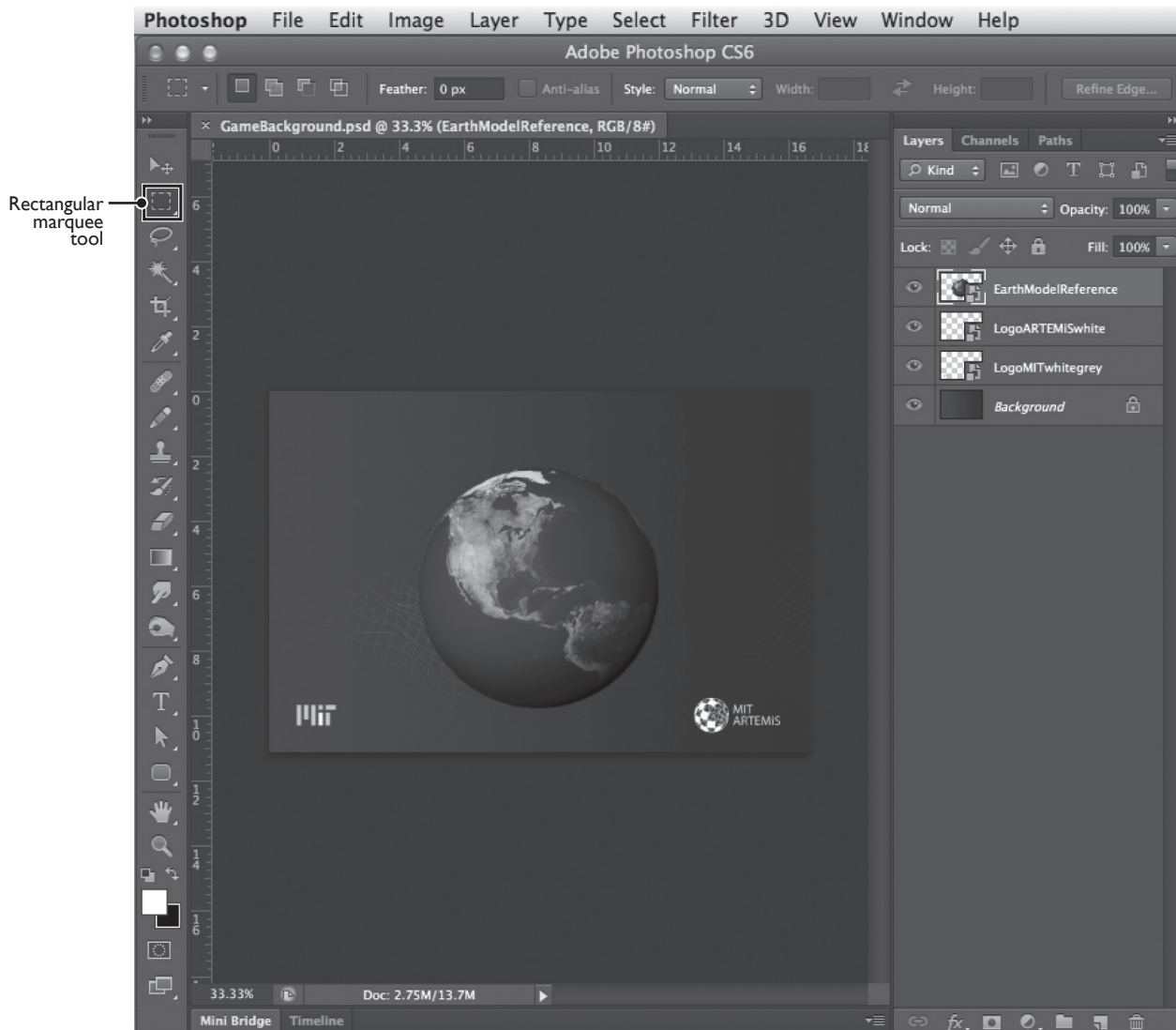

# Storyboarding in Photoshop and Illustrator

### Photoshop Actions

Open a file	File>Open ( <b>Command O</b> )	Scale proportionally	Hold <b>Shift</b> while dragging
View/change image size	Image>Image Size	Import an image	File>Place - click check mark at top to accept changes
Change canvas size	Image>Canvas Size	Save image	File>Save As <b>(Shift Command S)</b> -change format to PNG
Transform	Edit>Transform		
Remove selection box	Select>Deselect

# Storyboarding in Photoshop and Illustrator

### Illustrator Actions

Create a new document	File>New ( <b>Command N</b> )	Transform	Select object (with black arrow tool)
Import an image	Image>Place	Scale proportionally	Hold <b>Shift</b> while dragging
Save new document	File>Save As ( <b>Shift Command S</b> ) - choose EPS (embeds imported images)	Save slices	File>Save for Web ( <b>Alt Shift Command S</b> )
