Drawing in Illustrator

Actions

Open a document File>Open (**Command O**)

Draw a line perfectly straight Hold **Shift** while drawing horizontally or vertically

Interface

Tools and Panels Annotations:

- Stroke thickness**: Points to the "Weight" field in the Stroke panel.
- Stroke panel**: Points to the entire Stroke panel.
- Arrowhead options**: Points to the "Arrowheads" dropdown menu in the Stroke panel.

Stroke Panel Details:

- Weight: 2 pt
- Cap: Square
- Corner: Mitered
- Limit: 10 x
- Align Stroke: Left
- Arrowheads: Arrow 1
- Scale: 100%
- Align: Center
- Profile: Uniform
- Character: Myriad Pro, Regular, 12 pt
- Paragraph: Auto
